Dear Sir / Madam;

I write as the founder of 'Serbian Animals Voice' which is dedicated to the protection of stray animals within Serbia.

I write specifically regarding a photograph which has been sent to our office recently showing a stray dog which has been run over and killed by the driver of a car in Belgrade city. As nobody can be seen in the vehicle when the photograph was taken (see picture below), we can only assume that the driver was fully aware of what he / she had done; but they continued to go about their business without any due consideration for the animals suffering.

It is more than clear from the photograph the make (KIA), type, colour and registration number (BG 1094 KC) of the vehicle which we refer to. As such, it will be no problem whatsoever for the police in Belgrade to use the vehicle type and registration number to track / find the owner / driver of the vehicle, and to question them on the killing; and prosecute for the abuse of an animal. Serbian law must be applied.

Please inform if this issue has already been addressed by yourselves or the Belgrade police. We require information on the status of current actions as we may need to take this further and also involve our global visitors which you can view on the above link.

I hope to hear from you very soon with a positive response confirming action is currently being taken. If we do not hear from you by 30/9/17 then we will have to assume that you are taking no action(s); and we will further matters after this date.

We have regular contacts within Serbia who we know have also contacted you about this incident. They will also keep us informed of future events and if you are taking any action to prosecute and keep them informed of events.
